MARCH 14th

Reds (solid)
**black on bottom*

MARCH 21st

Earth Tones
**black on bottom*

MARCH 28th

Black & White
**black on bottom*

APRIL 4th (EASTER)

Greens (SOLID)
**black on bottom*

APRIL 11th

Blues (solid)
**black on bottom*

APRIL 18th

Reds (solid)
**black on bottom*

APRIL 25th

Earth Tones
**black on bottom*

MAY 2nd

Black & White
**black on bottom*

MAY 9th

Blues (solid)
**black on bottom*

MAY 16th

Reds (solid)
**black on bottom*

MAY 23rd

Earth Tones
**black on bottom*

MAY 30th

Black & White
**black on bottom*

DRESS CODE REMINDER:

We are currently working with a “color coordination” system. We use the colors listed in the schedule. Things to keep in mind:

- Your default color will always be black, and can be worn in any combination with these colors. If you don't have some of the colors, you can ALWAYS WEAR BLACK
- Gentlemen- black pants
- Ladies- black pants/capris or skirts
- No jeans, tennis shoes, or neck ties
- Patterns are fine as long as they are not distracting & loud
- Light patterns are ok on “solid color” days, but solid color shirts are preferred
 - Blues, Reds, & Earth Tones are solid color shirt days

WOMEN:

- Shirts shouldn't be tight, low cut, off the shoulders, sleeveless, clingy or short
- Pants/Skirts shouldn't be tight or clingy
- Skirt/Dress lengths should be below the knee, even when sitting
- Slits in skirts shouldn't be above the knee, even when sitting
- No leggings
- Black pantyhose are a good idea b/c it will look more uniform (just an option, not a mandate)

MEN:

- No casual shirts or sweatshirts
- No neck ties
- No shorts

COLOR KEY:

- **BLACK & WHITE** = solid black/white shirt or black/white shirt with accents (a pattern) of the opposite color
- **BLUES** = solid color shirts of blue hues (ex: light, dark, royal, etc. NOT TEAL!!)
- **REDS** = solid color shirts of red hues
- **EARTH TONES**= solid browns, khaki, tan, NOT OLIVE GREEN!!
